A G R E E M E N T

as to burials.

coloured pink AND WHEREAS the said land belongs to the University of Oxford who have agreed to sell the same to the Board of Admiralty and to convey it to the Incumbent for an extension of the said Churchyard AND WHEREAS it is proposed that the Admiralty shall as soon as the said land has been so conveyed fence the same and do all things usually necessary to be done to put the same into good order and thereafter for ever maintain it in such good order and condition and further that all such burials therein shall be conducted by Naval Chaplains at the expense of the Board of Admiralty and that the Incumbent shall not have any right to

any burial fees in connection with such burials.

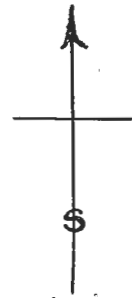
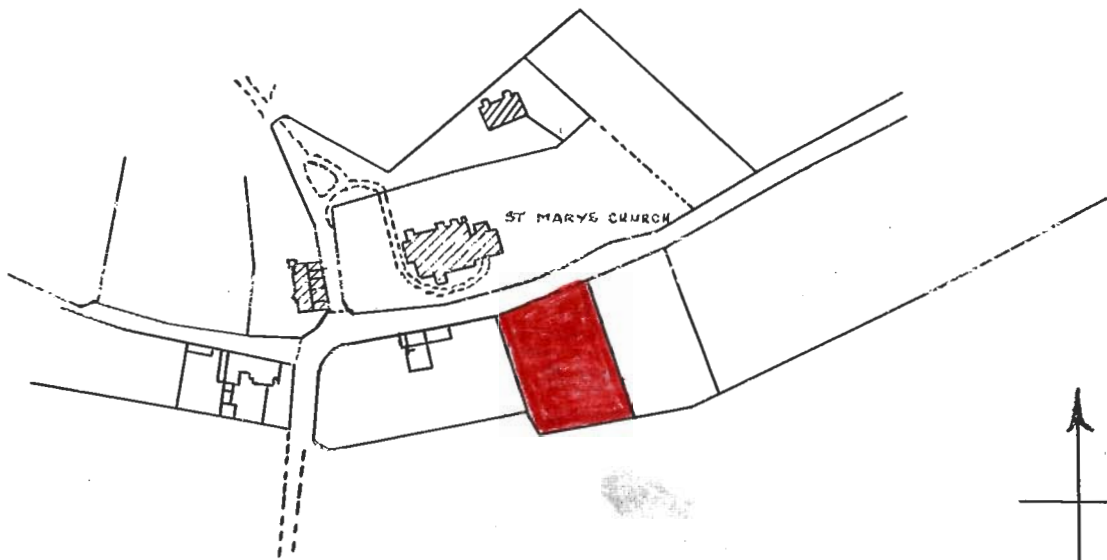
IT IS THEREFORE AGREED as follows :-

1. The Board of Admiralty shall at their own cost cause the said land to be conveyed to the Incumbent under the Consecration of Churchyards Act 1867 as an extension to the existing Churchyard for the said Parish of Shotley for the purpose of Naval burials and the Incumbent shall accept such Conveyance.
2. All Naval burials in the said extension shall be conducted by Naval Chaplains at the expense of the Board of Admiralty.
3. The Incumbent shall not be entitled to any burial fees for such burials in the said extension and he hereby waives his rights (if any) to the same.
