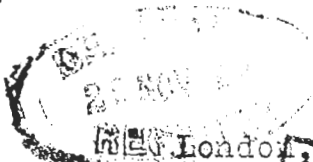

Dear Sir John,

Once again I am troubling you with some requirements from my Authorities in Buenos Aires. This time they would be interested to obtain any programmes you might have regarding the selection of candidates for posts as Radiotelegraphic and Signalling operators, as well as the syllabus of instruction of this personnel in your Navy.

I would therefore be very grateful if you could kindly supply me with such programmes. The points of most interest for my Authorities, among others, would be:

- a) Special physical conditions required in candidates (auditive conditions for the radiotelegraphic and visual for the signalling operators);
- b) Level of general education required. Average level of education required for their entry.
- c) Tests by which candidates are selected for entry. Details of same. Results that candidates must obtain to be considered apt (suitable);
- d) Any other information that could be of interest for the selection.

All the information you could kindly supply on the subject would be greatly appreciated, for illustration purposes.
