

D.S.D. has read Senior Psychologist's minute with much interest.

2. D.S.D. considers, however, that the reply to N.A. should be couched in the simplest practical terms, and be accompanied by the syllabus - again in general terms - up to the time of leaving the Training Establishment only. (* in N.A's letter).

3. D.S.D. recommends, therefore, that this correspondence be sent to GANGES and that GANGES should be invited to draft a reply on the lines of D.S.D's para. 2 above.
