

TRIAL OF THE EX-KAISER.

Sir Gordon Hewart, the Attorney-General, speaking at Pontypridd last night, referred to the proposed trial of the ex-Kaiser, and declared that it was untrue to suggest that there were any dissensions, on the one hand, or wavering, on the other, with reference to this vitally important matter.

The Law Officers of the Crown had already made, and were still making, the most careful and extensive preparations for the arrival of the day when the trial will begin. There had already been examined more than 50,000 written statements with reference to the matter of prosecuting criminals for acts done in the course of the war. His audience could infer from that fact the magnitude of the task, and he asked them not to be led away by those who suggested that this matter was not receiving the most careful and day-to-day attention.
