

RETIRED RANK TO CHIEF WARRANT OFFICERS.—
 RETIRED OFFICERS CALLED OUT IN EMER-
 GENCY, &c.

XVI.—*Rank to Chief Gunners, Chief Boatswains and
 Chief Carpenters, and to Chief Officers of Coastguard
 on Retirement.*

1. Chief Gunners and Chief Boatswains, who have served three years in these ranks may be granted, at the discretion of the Admiralty, when pensioned the retired and honorary rank of Lieutenant.

2. Chief Carpenters with not less than three years' service as such may be granted, at the discretion of the Admiralty, relative rank with Lieutenant on retirement.

3. Chief Officers of Coast Guard, who have served three years in charge of Divisions, may be granted, at the discretion of the Admiralty, the retired and honorary rank of Lieutenant when pensioned.

4. The Retiring Pensions for Chief and other Warrant Officers are set forth in Article 1978 of the Queen's
