1. You are being released from Service, by order made under authority of the Naval and Marine Forces (Temporary Release from Service) Act, 1940, as a Class A Release. (See Note 2.)

2. The date of your Release will be **2nd. March 1946.**

3. You have been granted leave as follows, starting on the day after the date of this Order:—

5. You may wear civilian clothing while on leave, and you are to cease to wear uniform after the date of your release.

6. After your release you will be regarded as being in Reserve and you will be liable until the end of the present emergency to recall to the Naval Service by revocation of this Order at any time. You will not be recalled, however, except in extreme emergency. (See Note 3.)

7. Your home address is noted in official records as follows: **1, Osborne Road, Northampton.**

You are to report all changes to the Commodore of your Depot (if a Royal Naval Reservist to the Registrar General, Shipping and Seamen, Llantrisant Road, Llandaff, Cardiff; if a Royal Marine to the Commandant of your Division). **While you are on leave you should also report any changes of address to the Officer in Charge of the Pay Office from which you were paid.**

8. Your Service Certificate will be sent to you after your Release.

9. You should carry this Order with you until your Service Certificate is received and you are to produce it when required.
