

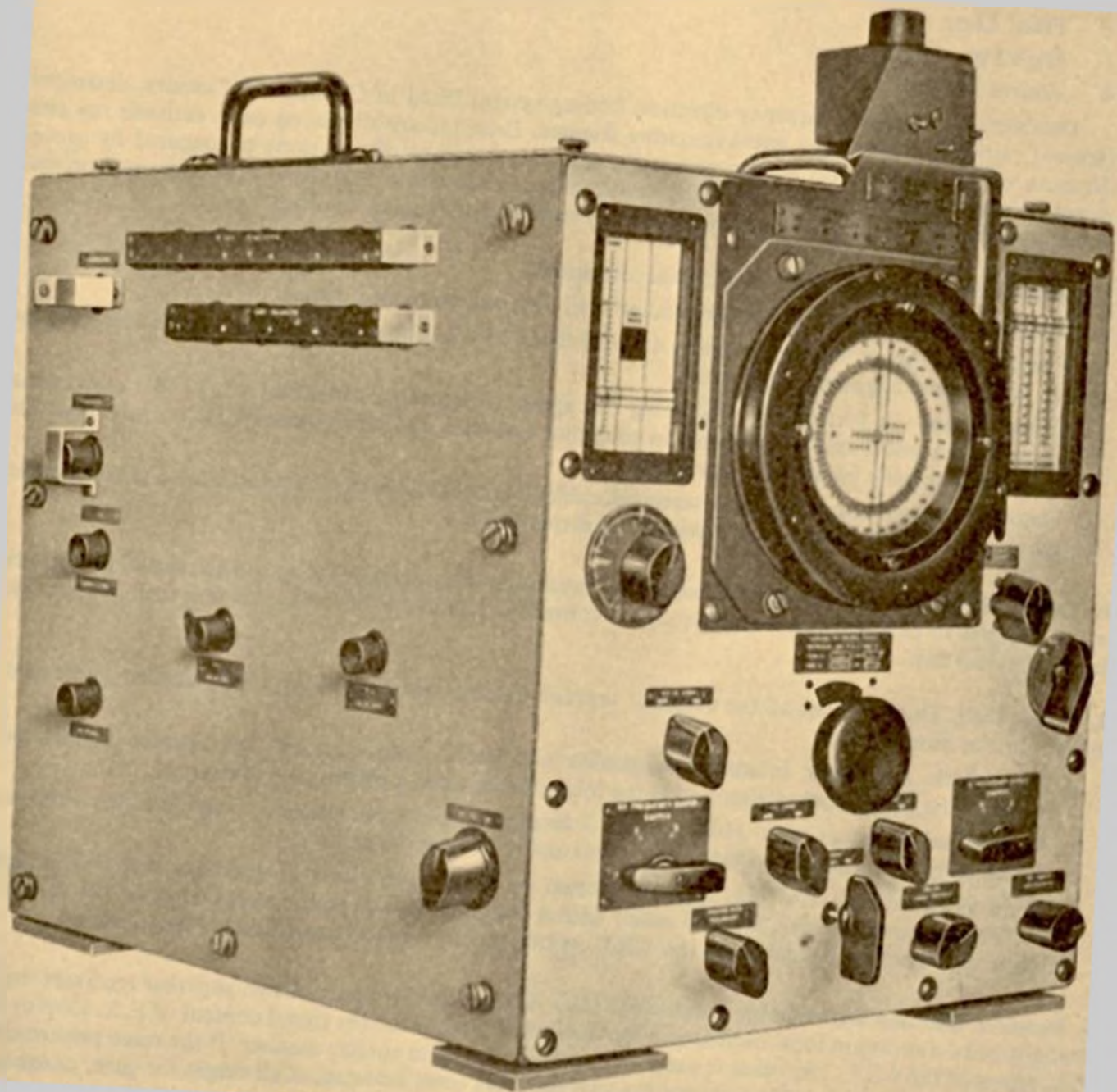

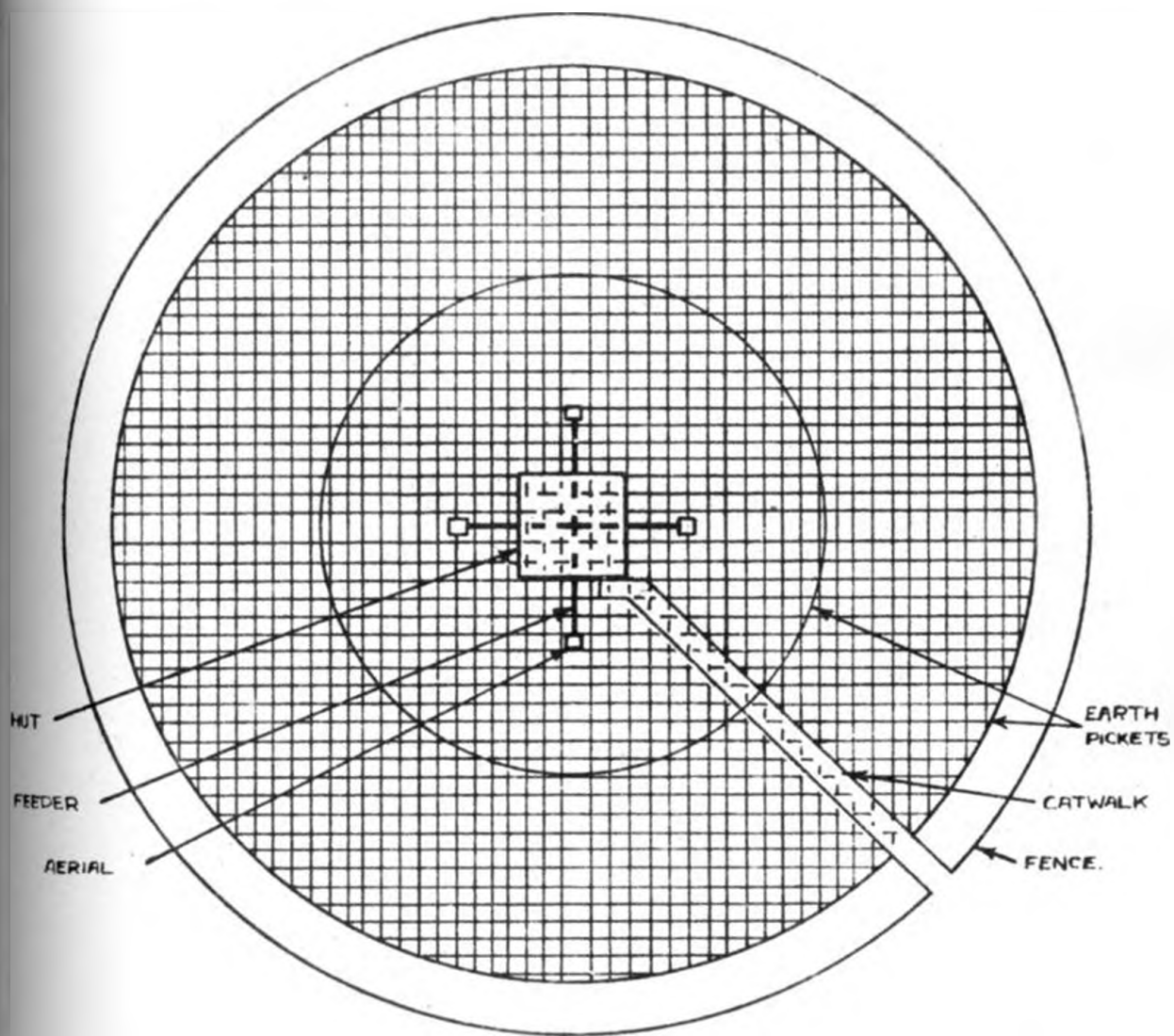

ADMIRALTY SIGNAL ESTABLISHMENT.

DIRECTION FINDING (D/F)

D/F equipment is capable of determining the direction from which signals are coming. It is an invaluable aid to lost aircraft. Naval aircraft do not at present carry D/F sets. Instead, they make use of D/F sets in ships or at aerodromes. When the aircraft needs a D/F bearing it transmits a message to its base asking for one. Its base takes a bearing of the aircraft transmissions and either tells the aircraft what it bears from the base or what course to steer to return to base.

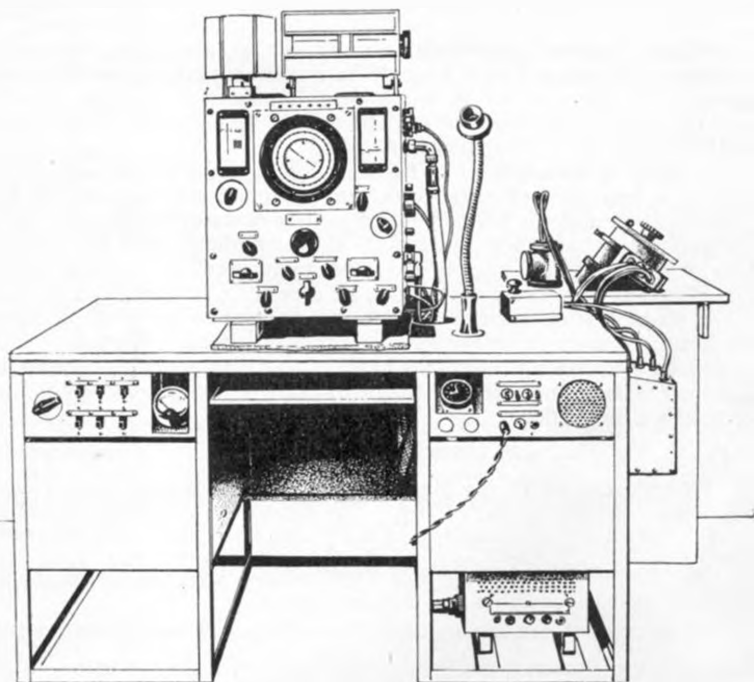


Fig. 88. D/F equipment—A.H.6
