

The following instructions are circulated for the guidance of Officers of H.M. Ships when fitting ships with the Service Type II. installation of Wireless Telegraphy.

This handbook is not intended to be used in connection with the construction of the office or silent cabinet, or for any of the work which is ordinarily done by the Dockyard or shipbuilder; it is intended to give all information required by the ship's staff, both as regard their share of the work of fitting out and also as regards the repair, maintenance, and ordinary working of the apparatus and instruments.

The work which is done by the Dockyards is described in a series of "Fitting-out Specifications," which are frequently revised to suit varying arrangements as each new class of ship is considered.

It must be borne in mind that a shock from the high tension side of the transformer will be instantly fatal, and that a shock from the alternating mains will be exceedingly dangerous. All these dangerous circuits are completely protected by safety gear, and if the instructions contained in this book are carried out, there can be no risk to anyone when fitting out or using the set.
