IN CHARGE OF MALTA DOCKYARD.

REAR-ADMIRAL JAMES L. HAMMETT, AND HIS STAFF.

The Admiral Superintendent of Malta Dockyard, who is here shown with Flag-lieutenant Reginald Henniker-Heaton and Secretary Richard B. Hosking, has seen much service. He was slightly wounded during an expedition in China, when a sub-lieutenant, and as a commander, served in the "Minotaur" during the Egyptian War of 1882. The medal ribbons on his left breast represent these services, while that upon the right is the ribbon of the Royal Humane Society's decoration, which he wears with a clasp for having twice saved life at sea.
