S47/75. STORES—CLOTHING—ISSUING PRICES, KIT UPKEEP ALLOWANCES, ETC. (U)

1. The issuing prices of clothing have been reviewed in the light of current costs and the revised issuing prices are set out in ANNEXES B to I of this DCI.
2. The rates of Kit Upkeep Allowance, Clothing Gratuities, etc have been re-calculated from the revised issuing prices and the new rates and amounts are set out in ANNEX A.
3. The revised rates of KUA will apply from 1 April 1975 and the new issuing prices are also to be brought into force on that date or in the event of delay in receipt of the DCI as soon as convenient thereafter but not later than 1 May 1975.
4. It is intended that the new prices and rates should remain in force for a period of three years unless there are any scale or price variations of sufficient significance to justify an interim revision.
5. The various price lists, rates of allowance, etc are shown in the ANNEXES as follows:
