
GIRL IN AUSTRALIAN'S UNIFORM.

At Bow-street Police Court yesterday, before Mr. Garrett, ROSE YOUNG, 25, machinist, of Eastbourne-terrace, Paddington, was charged with unlawfully wearing military uniform.

A police-constable stated that yesterday morning he saw the girl in Tottenham Court-road, dressed, as she appeared in the dock, in an Australian's service jacket, breeches, and puttees. On the jacket were several chevrons, the general service medal ribbon, and a wound stripe. She appeared to be waiting for an omnibus, and on being questioned said that an Australian soldier had lent her the clothes for a peace dance.

The defendant was bound over to come up for judgment if called upon, the MAGISTRATE remarking that he had no doubt she did this for a lark, but she was liable to a heavy penalty for bringing the King's uniform into discredit.
