

nigg still hoped against hope that he might be able to save his country; but we know that within a few weeks he had disappeared behind the doors of a Nazi prison.

So Austria became the spring-board for other Nazi conquests; to-day it is an Arsenal of Nazi military might. The vast modern aircraft factory in Wiener Neustadt, the Hermann Goering works in Linz and Hirtenberg are producing an increasing quantity of war material. The country has also become a place of refuge for Nazi leaders and their wives, trying to escape from the R.A.F.

Yet, as I listen to the broadcasts from Russia of captured Austrian airmen, as reports of "incidents" in Austria filter through, I wonder whether the day may not be near when the Austrian people, trained by the Nazis in the arts of revolt, will give Hitler a dose of his own medicine.
