Group	Suffix Letters etc.	Meaning
Control System	A	An extempore W/T set made to Admiralty instructions
	B	Spare letter
	C	The "Central Control System" (C.C.S.)
	D	The "Centralised W/T System" (C.W.S.)
Type of Power Supply	No letter	Fed from own machines or ship's mains
	E	Fed from batteries and available when main power supplies fail
	F	Fed from Standard A.C. Supply
	G	Spare letter
Portions of Sets	No letter	The whole set is fitted
	H	The H.F. portion of the set only fitted
	J	The V.H.F. portion of the set only fitted
	K	Spare letter
	L	The L.F. or M.F. portion of the set only fitted
Major Modifications	No letter	The standard set
	M	The set after the first major modification
	P	The set after the second major modification
	Q	The set after the third major modification
		<u>Note.</u> A major modification is defined as a modification necessitating new drawings and Establishment list of stores
	A.C. Ships	An existing set modified for fitting in A.C. Ships
Miscellaneous Descriptions	R	The set has R.T. fitted
	S	A ship set adapted for shore use
	T	A transportable version of a set which is used for other purposes

Group	Suffix Letters etc.	Meaning
Type of Ship	No letter	A set that may be fitted in any class of ship without modification, or a set fitted in only one class of ship.
	U	The set modified for use in small craft (e.g. M.T.B's etc. below 500 tons).
	V	The set modified for use in Flotilla Leaders, Destroyers and similar small ships.
	W	The set modified for use in Submarines.
Experimental Sets	X	First experimental set.
	Y	Second experimental set (i.e. First experimental set after major modification)
	Z	Third experimental set (i.e. Second experimental set after major modification)
